# STUDY TOUR TO INDIA TENTATIVE ITINERARY (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

#### **ACTUAL ITINERARY WILL BE UPDATED AND SET IN 2019**

- The study tour will begin with 3 days in the capital city of Delhi, visiting important historic, social, cultural and religious sites in this complex metropolis. It will include a visit to the Indian Social Institute which aims to effect social transformation through socially relevant research and advocacy in partnership with marginalized communities.
- We will visit Agra to see the beautiful Taj Mahal.
- We will then travel east to the Darjeeling District of West Bengal where we will spend 8
  days hosted by the Jesuits of Darjeeling. There will be excursions to several projects working
  in the areas of human rights, workers' rights, food security, access to education, sustainable
  livelihoods, health and economic development.
- The study tour will conclude with 3 days in Kolkata.
