- ***Under the MAIN (Migrant Assistance & Information Network) India initiative led by the Indian Social Institute, New Delhi. Our community leaders & volunteers in Maharashtra identified the most vulnerable sectors that are exposed to poverty and covid virus. most of the sectors were in Amravati in Maharashtra.***
- ***In the Amravati district of Maharashtra the community workers visited four villages :-***
 - (1) Pandharakhadak***
 - (2) Menghat***
 - (3) Zingapur***
 - (4) Ahad***

Of Chikhaldhara taluka.

Each village was visited five times during the month.
- ***In the month of June 2021, we gave medicines for covid symptomatic sickness to 276 persons. Awareness programs were held in small groups. Around 800 people participated in these covid awareness talks. everything was conducted following all covid-19 safety guidelines with proper social distancing.***
