The Jesuits in Haiti accompany vulnerable families affected by the August 2021 earthquake through housing reconstruction in the south of Haiti. The project aims **to build 120 houses** by the end of May 2023 in four rural communities in the South and Grande Anse Departments; provide psychosocial and spiritual support to families affected by the earthquake; and provide training to improve their quality of life. This interim report presents the results achieved as of February 2023.

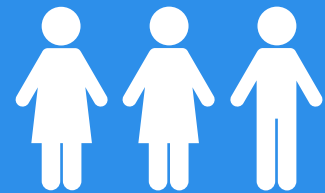

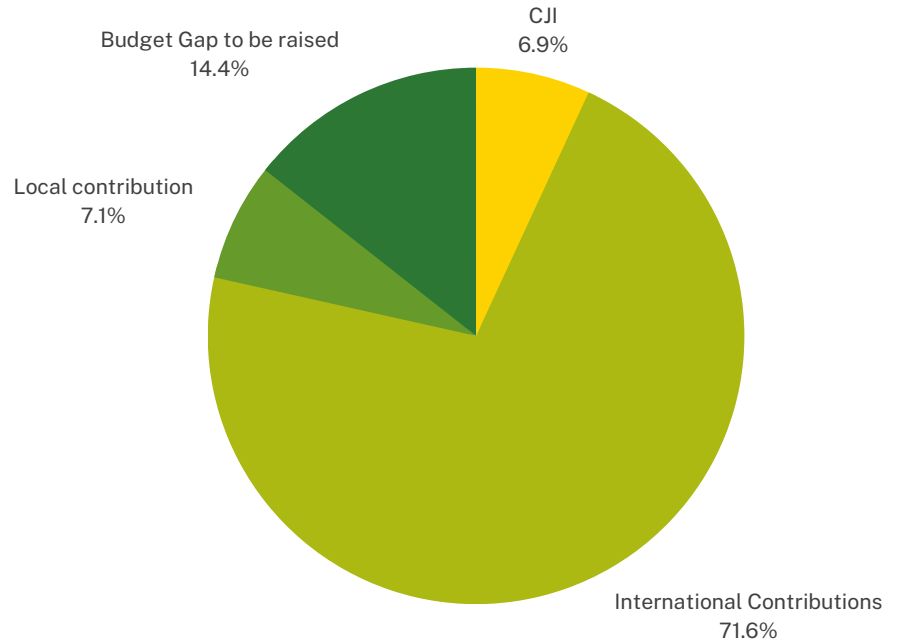
