



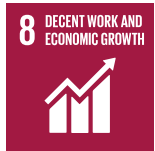

In 2022, CJI financed the installation of a solar electricity generation and storage system, which has enhanced the delivery of services and increased staff efficiency.



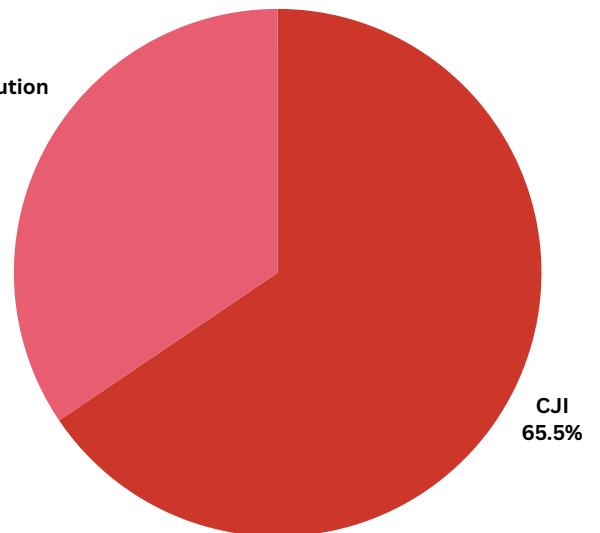
