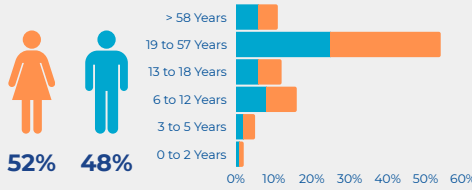

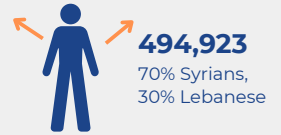
Displacement Demographics*

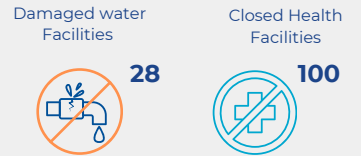

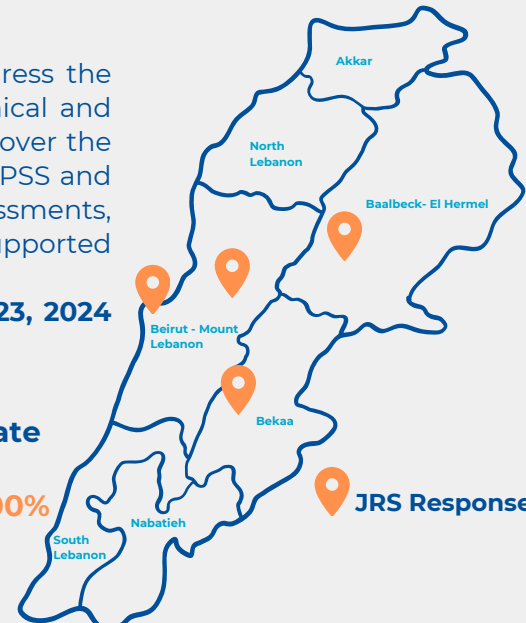

JRS Response

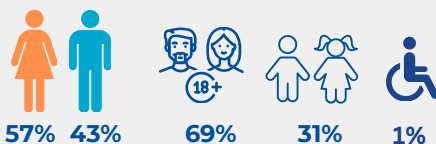
JRS continues to scale up its humanitarian response in Lebanon to address the urgent needs of those affected by the escalating conflict. The JRS technical and operational teams have been actively coordinating with key stakeholders over the past week to strategize the next phase of activities, which will include MHPSS and protection services. This effort has involved comprehensive needs assessments, situational analysis, and the evaluation of feedback gathered from supported centers to ensure tailored and responsive service delivery. All numbers reported reflect JRS response activities starting **September 23, 2024** until **October 25, 2024**.

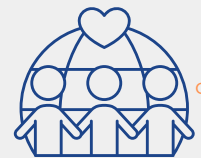
